DECLARATION OF JENNIFER N.
ROSEN VALVERDE REGARDING
PLAINTIFFS' MOTION FOR
PRELIMINARY APPROVAL OF
SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

I, Jennifer N. Rosen Valverde, hereby declare:

I am an attorney licensed to practice law in the State of New Jersey,
 and I am admitted to the United States District Court for the District of New
 Jersey. My firm, the Education and Health Law Clinic at Rutgers University

School of Law, represents *Amici Curiae* in this matter. I make this declaration based upon my personal knowledge. If called to testify, I could testify competently to the facts in this declaration.

- 2. On June 23, 2023, as counsel for *Amici Curiae*, I wrote to the Court raising concerns with the Settlement Agreement submitted for preliminary approval on June 9, 2023. ECF No. 464.
- 3. During the fall of 2023, as counsel for *Amici Curiae*, I was involved in the negotiations to revise the Settlement Agreement to address the concerns raised in ECF No. 464.
- 4. Class Counsel also consulted me, as counsel for *Amici Curiae*, in drafting the proposed Notice.
- The clients I represent will not be raising objections to the revised
   Settlement Agreement.
- 6. One of my clients, New Jersey Special Education Practitioners
  (NJSEP), is comprised of individual attorneys and advocates within the State of
  New Jersey. Because the revised Agreement has not been signed, I have not yet
  shared it with the individual members of NJSEP; however, the designated
  representative of NJSEP has reviewed and approved the Agreement. I cannot
  represent to the Court whether any member of NJSEP, in his or her individual
  capacity, will have concerns about the Agreement. However, I would not be able to

represent any individual NJSEP member who did have a concern because my clients support the Settlement Agreement.
